

The campaign

Many people campaign about the unfairness of many aspects of the telecoms industry and the ways in which telecoms services are used (or misused).

The **fair telecoms campaign** aims to focus these campaigning energies and concerns. Its purpose is to maximise the effectiveness of individual efforts and enable collective representations to be made where necessary.

The issues

Topics currently receiving attention include:

- The improper use of revenue sharing 084 numbers, e.g. by public bodies and in particular NHS providers.
- Ofcom's failure to properly address the issue of Silent Calls.
- The ineffectiveness of action by the Information Commissioner to stop use of recorded message marketing calls.
- Ofcom's current proposals to introduce clarity to the charging arrangements for calls to all non-geographic numbers.
