



**New Telephone Customer Service Regulations -  
Well-known companies believed to be in breach**

On Friday 13 June new regulations came into force demanding that if customers are offered a telephone number to contact a trader, it must be one that is charged at the "basic rate", i.e. beginning 01, 02 or 03.

We have been monitoring compliance and are delighted to report that very many companies have recently changed their 084 and 087 numbers to the equivalent 034 and 037 numbers.

Many who offer a 0800 number have provided alternative numbers for mobile callers to use, up until these become "freephone" in June 2015.
